Outline Job Description for Handyman

Desford Parish Council is seeking to hire a handyman to assist the Council in carrying out various small jobs around the Parish.

Examples of jobs that the handyman would be asked to complete are:

- Slabbing – small areas for pedestrian use.
- Installation of noticeboards.
- Painting.
- Cleaning signs/bus shelters.
- Fixing items to walls (eg - bike rack).
- Minor maintenance to childrens' play areas.
- Fixing and removing mobile speed cameras; (for example, mounted on lamp posts approximately 2.5 to 3 metres off the ground).

The workload is intermittent but is likely to be approximately 8 to 10 hours each month.

Applicants will be self-employed and are asked to provide their hourly rates in writing and a reference. Applicants should also be able to provide public liability insurance for the work.
