3. Neighbourhood Plan: We are still waiting for the responses to the SEA before we can move onto the next stage of the review.

- **4. Davidsons:** a meeting had been held to discuss the path outside the Primary School. Davidsons put forward a proposal to create a new access off Kirkby Road, for pedestrians approaching from their development. The next step will be for a design/plan to be submitted to HBBC and LCC.
- **5. Jelsons:** the appeal hearing starts tomorrow, 5th March.
- **6. Griffen:** the work to the pavement has been completed. There is no indication of when the second phase might start. The liaison group had a site meeting and discussed various works which are still to be completed. Responsibility for the unofficial lay-by close to the bridleway entrance is being investigated as this has not been tarmacked.
- **7. Owl Homes:** The S278 works have not been completed (to correct the access junction and to create the pedestrian access). We have been notified that LCC has given permission for a road closure later in March for this work to be done.
- **8. Co-op application:** There has been no further update.
- **9. Miller Homes:** a meeting had been held with representatives and they encouraged us to proceed with the Neighbourhood Plan review.
- **10.Bellway:** a meeting had been held with representatives and options will be discussed at the next meeting of the Neighbourhood Plan Working Group.
